Hurricane Harvey

In August, we experienced a storm that created widespread damage in the Dickinson area. We estimate about 1/3 of the homes in our subdivision were damaged. Most have begun the rebuilding process. The board would like to remind residents of a deed restriction regarding yard signs. It is:

Section 9 Signs and Billboards

“No signs, billboards, banners, streamers, contractor’s signs, posters or advertising devices of any character shall be erected, permitted or maintained on any lot or plot except for a sign no larger than 6 sq.ft. advertising that property for sale or rent, except as allowed by State Law.”

Note: The City is finished collecting debris in our neighborhood and will not pick up any new construction debris. Please make arrangements to dispose of debris in other ways than piles near the street.
