Deed Restriction Review

All Deed Restrictions can be found on the website www.sherwoodforestwest.org. Here is one example of a deed restriction.

Article III Section 12 (d)

Any and all types of motor vehicles are prohibited from being parked on any part of the Lot other than the driveway or inside a garage, and the vehicles must be positioned to prevent the blocking of a sidewalk at all times.

Parking, UTV's, Golf Carts

There have been a growing number of UTV's and golf carts on the streets of Sherwood Forest West. We ask that all you operate these please do so safely and according to the Texas Transportation Code. A golf cart must contain these five items.

1. Headlamps
2. Tail lamps
3. Reflectors
4. Parking brake
5. Mirrors

Parking

We ask that when parking in the streets please beware of your neighbor's driveway. There are some that have difficulty backing out of their driveways because of street parking. If you park directly across from a driveway this may not need to be the best place to park. Let's be polite to our neighbors and please make adjustments as best we can.

Lawn Care Companies

Please make sure your lawn care company is not blowing any lawn debris into your neighbor's yard, the streets and drainage systems. Our drainage system is strained as it is and we do not need to add to problem and surely your neighbor does not want to pick up your clippings either.

Trees

Please be aware there has been a report about low hanging trees in the subdivision the school bus is having a difficult time moving thru the streets. Damage can be costly to these vehicles so let's do our part so they maneuver down the street with ease.

Commercial Property

There has been activity with the commercial property just to the north of us behind Kings Court. The board is in contact with League City officials and is doing our due diligence to protect our neighbors on Kings Court and will continue to do so.
